In Ireland, civil registration of non-Catholic marriages began on 1 April 1845 with births, death, and Catholic marriages following on 1 January 1864. In 1922 Ireland was partitioned into Northern Ireland (counties of, Antrim, Armagh, Derry, Down, Fermanagh, and Tyrone which remained a part of the UK and the Irish Free State which became the Republic of Ireland in 1949.
