"Some diseases listed under **Cause of Death** are archaic terms that are rarely heard now. The following definitions were found on a variety of Internet sites.

**Bloody Flux -** inflammation of the large bowel; commonly known as colitis.

**Consumption** - usually referred to pulmonary tuberculosis; sometimes called marasmus.

**Dropsy** - edema; the presence of abnormally large amounts of fluid, often caused by kidney disease or congestive heart failure.

**Summer Complaint** - diarrhea, usually in infants, often caused by drinking spoiled milk.

**Teething** - since infants were often weaned at the time of teething, it is surmised that they may have died from drinking contaminated milk, or from malnutrition if watered-down milk was given."
