Mrs... William Gruetzmacher died last Thursday noon very suddenly and after having been ill but a few hours. She arose early in the morning, at about 4:00 and a sudden fall to the floor aroused the household. She was found lying on the floor with a slight cut on the knee but said she was not injured and would be all right. Although she did not wish a doctor, Dr. Fairchild was called later in the morning.

Funeral services will be held next Sunday afternoon at 2:00 from the Embarrass Lutheran Church. Burial will be in the Pella Opening Cemetery.

Mrs... Caroline Gruetzmacher was born in Strelehagan, Province of Naugart, Germany, December 18, 1835. She was married to William Gruetzmacher in 1863. They came to America in 1882 locating in the Town of Larabee on an 80 acre farm. Here they toiled hard, soon cleared the land and developed a good farm. In 1894 they turned the farm over to their son August and they continued to reside on that farm until a year ago when they moved with him to Embarrass.

She is survived by her aged husband, 5 children, Charles, August and William, Mrs... Fred Born of Pella and Mrs... Peter Gorky of Birnanwood, one brother residing at Shawano; 22 grandchildren and 27 great grandchildren.

## Notes for Freiderick (Fritz) ERDMANN:

Birth dates and marriage dates came from the 1900 Census. They were living with their third child, William at the time of the census. It shows Frederick's occupation as a farmer. They do not appear on the 1905 State Census. Another source of this record is, batch #8506006 and sheet #31 from the International Genealogical Index, LDS Library.

Marriage and death record came from 1900 census, Town of Pella, Shawano County, Wisconsin. Death record came from Obituary's, volume 4, page 30.

Friederick and Wilhelmina are buried at the Pella Opening Cemetery, Town of Pella, Shawano County, Wisconsin.

They immigrated from Germany in 1866 per 1900 Census.

Fred also appears on the state census for 1895, 1885, 1875.

Jefferson County Land Records show F. Erdmann with property located Sec. 1, Town 8, Range 15, dated 1862.

His death certificate shows carcinoma of the stomach as cause of death.

Contributory cause as "old age". The certificate also shows his parents as Karl Erdmann and Sophia Fulk.

A handwritten letter found in the possession of is granddaughter, Alvina Erdmann McBride of Mobile, Alabama reads:

Mr... Fritz Erdmann lived to a great old age, and was well known in the city and the county.

Mr... Erdmann was very feeble at the time of his death. He was born April 1, 1839 in Strehlowhagan near Naugard in Pommern. He was married in the year of 1867 and his oldest daughter was born in Germany and the other children were born in this country. He came from Germany to Dodge County near Mayville and in the year of 1869 moved to Pella in Shawano County. Mr... Erdmann lived his last old days in the old homestead with is son William until he died.

Mr... Erdmann was a learnt cabinet maker and a man who understood his work and he was kept very busy. His wife and children took care of the farm and later worked it. He built houses, bridges and chimneys near Pella in his younger years and was a very hard worker. In the spring nine years ago his wife died. He leaves six children, 32 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren. One sister and one brother.

He was buried on Sunday evening from the Lutheran Church in Pella. Pastor Schilling conducted the sermon He rests in peace.

Obituary: The body of the late Friederick Erdmann was laid to rest last Sunday afternoon after funeral services held in the Pella Lutheran Church. the many people present at the church was evidence of the high esteem in which he and his family are held in the community. Mr... Erdmann was one of the pioneer farmers of Pella locating there in 1869. He developed a splendid farm and at times also followed his trade as a carpenter. Of the seven children six remain to mourn his death and all were present at the funeral except Frank who resides in Alabama and was unable to attend. The surviving children are Mrs... Robert Habeck, Mrs... Herman Wolfe, William, Frank, Albert and Charley. He also leaves an aged brother, William Erdmann and a sister, Caroline Gruetzmacher, 32 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren.

Those from away attending the funeral were Mr... and Mrs... Robert Habeck, Mr... and Mrs... Charles Erdmann and sons, Mr... and Mrs... John Ludolph, Mr... and Mrs... Frank Kriewald of Shawano; Mrs... Peter Jockey of Birnamwood and many friends from Marion, Belle Plaine and Clintonville.

WILL of Fred Erdmann: I, Fred Erdmann, of the Town of Pella in the County of Shawano, State of Wisconsin, being of sound mind and memory, and mindful of the uncertainties of human life, do make, publish, and declare this, my last will and testament, as follows.

FIRST: After the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses, I give and bequeath to my son Frank Erdmann, the sum of one-thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).

SECOND: My sons, William Erdmann and Charles Erdmann, have heretofore received their share of my estate and are therefore herein excluded, but it is my wish that my said son William Erdmann, who has received the greatest share of my estate, shall give me a decent and Christian burial at my decease, and defray the expenses thereof.

THIRD: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, of whatever name, title or description, real, personal or mixed, I give, devise and bequeath to my son, Albert Erdmann; my daughter, Bertha Wolfe, nee Erdmann; and my daughter, Ida Habeck, nee Erdmann, to be equally divided between them, share and share alike, except that my one share of bank stock in the Embarrass State Bank of Embarrass, Wisconsin shall not be divided but shall go to my son, Albert Erdmann, and shall be and constitute a part of his one-third share in the residue above mentioned.

FOURTH: I hereby constitute and appoint my son, Albert Erdmann, executor of this my last will and testament; and hereby authorize and empower him, the said Albert Erdmann, to compound, compromise, and settle any claim or demand which may be against or in favor of my said estate; and I hereby direct, that my said executor be not required to give bond or security for the faithful performance of said trust.

### Notes for Wilhelm Karl ERDMANN:

Obituary, June 11, 1925: Wilhelm Karl Erdmann, died at the age of 83 years, 9 months and 3 days. He was born on 2 September 1841 in Strehlow By Hagen, Pommerania, Germany, son of Karl Erdmann and Friedericke Falk. He was confirmed in 1854 at Karzig, Pommern. In 1866 he came to America with relatives. In 1868 he married Bertha Eggert. Survivors besides his son-in-law are only his nephew and niece and their children.

Cause of death was old age, superinduced by a tumorous growth.

Funeral services were held from the St Jacobi Church.

We have been unable to determine if the picture shown of Mr... and Mrs.. William Erdmann is William Karl Erdmann and wife Bertha Eggert or if it is William F. Karl Erdmann and wife Emilie Grimm. The life of another beloved, aged German Pioneer of Shawano County was ended Tuesday noon at nearly 1 o'clock when William Friederick Erdmann died at his home in the Town of Richmond.

Born in Germany on April 1, 1848, William Friederick Erdmann saw strife between many nations. He saw action in the war between Germany and France; and after returning from the war in 1870 married a German girl.

Came here in 1882

In 1882 the Erdmann family moved to America and settled in the Town of Richmond, Shawano County, near others who migrated from the Fatherland. Four years later, in 1886, Mrs... Erdmann passed away. Two years later, the young man married Ernestine Bratz who survives the deceased. Three sons and two daughter also survive the aged resident. They are Julius, on the home farm on which the deceased spent his entire life in America, William and Robert, Shawano, Mrs... Anna Krueger, Bonduel, and Mrs... Helen Jury, Antigo. One son, Frank died last October at Bonduel. Twenty one Grandchildren also mourn their Grandfathers death.

The funeral will be held in the Stoney Hill Lutheran Church. Rev. Cassens will officiate. Interment in the Stoney Hill Cemetery.
