Notes for Wilhelm (Julius) KOHN:

Wilhelm died approximately 3 years after marrying 3rd wife. Obituary states cause of death as bowel trouble. Death certificate states stomach cancer. He died in Germania, Wisconsin, Marquette County. The County seat is currently, Montell, Wisconsin. 608-207-2727.

His marriage certificate shows Mother as Friedericke Warder. Father as Wilhelm Kohn. This is confusing as the names on certificate look to be reversed ie: Father on Mothers Line and Mother on Fathers line. His brother, Albert's Mother is Freidericka Voleen. Marriage witnesses were, Albert Kohn and Wm. Borchardt. Clergy was Fr. Schneider.

Wilhelm with his first wife and daughters, Helene and Auguste Louise, possibly a daughter named Anne came from Germany. Auguste Louise learned how to walk on the trip to America. Wilhelm and his first wife then had a daughter named Agnes. His wife died in this childbirth. Wilhelm married second wife, Auguste Borchardt Steiner. She had a daughter named Anne Steiner. Auguste Borchardt Steiner Kohn died. Wilhelm then married his third wife Friedericke Auguste Borchardt Malzahn, a widow. She had had 4 children by Malzahn. She and Wilhelm then had 2 children. Wilhelm died in 1897 and Friedericke Auguste Borchardt Malzahn Kohn then married Wilhelms brother, Albert. They then had 2 children. Albert and Friedericke raised all of the children.

Since Wilhelms second and third wives maiden name was Borchardt, I believe his first wife was probably their sister. I was never able to find any name for her except the first name of Auguste.

The brothers Wilhelm and Albert lived in the Town of Germania, Shawano County, Wisconsin. South of Wittenberg. Wilhelm lived in Hunting, Wisconsin at one time. Hunting no longer exists. It is now part of the township of Grant in Shawano County. Wilhelm lived there until 1892.

Obituary: January 21, 1897, Wittenberg Enterprise

Wilhelm Kohn died Sunday at his home of some bowel trouble. He was about 45 years of age and leaves a widow and large family of children in destitute circumstances. The funeral was held from the German Lutheran Church, Tuesday, the services being conducted by Rev. List.

Anna Steiner/Steinke Pribbernow's obituary shows her parents as Julius Kuhn. I believe this to be Wilhelm Kohn as his other given names are not known and this is the only reference found to another given name. Anna was raised by Wilhelm and her mother Wilhelmina Borchardt Steiner Kohn. Wilhelmina's first husband, Steiner died young.

A land record for Julius Kohn is dated March 1, 1883 for 40 acres, document # 5751, township 33 N, Range 8 W, Section # 33. Base line is 4th PM - 1831.

Marriage witnesses were Fred Wolfe and W. A. Cheeseman

Albert Kohn was Town Supervisor for 20 years in Wittenberg, Wisconsin. Obituary said he was a good citizen and farmer.

He lived in Janesville for 17 years then moved to Wittenberg, Wisconsin. in 1897.

The 1900 Census for the Town of Germania, Wisconsin shows Albert and Fredericka with Ferdinand, Alvina, Alfred Kohn and Bertha, Auguste, Franz and Karl(Charles) living in same household.

The 1905 State Census for the Town of Germania, role CSUSAWI1905_28 has the father as Alo, mother as Fredericka W. and household members as Alo, Fridrick W., Alvina, Alfred A., Phillip F., Ferdinand A., Carl F. Malzahn and Edna F. Malzahn.

The 1910 Census, Town of Germania, shows Albert and Freidericka with Alvina, Alfred, Phillip and Bernard. Bernard is probably Ferdinand Albert as Ferdinand was born December 1900 and this census shows Bernard as 9 years old.

Obituary: Town of Germania, Albert Kohn passed away last Thursday

A well known farmer and long a resident in the Town of Germania passed away at his home Thursday evening. at the age of 76 years and 8 months following an illness of about a week. The immediate cause of his death was a cerebral hemorrhage. Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon with services conducted at the home and at St Pauls Lutheran Church, The Rev G. F. Fierke officiating. Interment was in Forest Home Cemetery. The pallbearers were William Mavis, Herman Borchardt, Frank Foth, George Schroeder, William Wieland and Alfred Hartwig. The flowers girls were Martha Foth, Mathilde Schroeder and Doretta and Ellenore Hartwig.

Mr... Kohn was a native of Pommerania, Germany, in which district near Stettin, he was born on September 17, 1857. He immigrated to this country about the year 1880 and lived at Janesville for about 17 years. He came to Wittenberg in the year 1897 and on March 19 of the following year he was married in this village to Mrs... William Kohn, who was previously Mrs... Malzahn and whose maiden name was Friedericke Borchardt. She passed away on June 16, 1927. Mr... Kohn took an active part in Town affairs and served as a supervisor for nearly 20 years. He was a good farmer and a good citizen. Two sons and five step-children survive him: Phillip and Ferdinand both at home; Alvina, Mrs... George Kriegle, of Tigerton; Alfred Kohn and Frank Malzahn of Shawano; Gusta, Mrs... Adolf Breaker of Laona and Bertha, Mrs... Eggleston of Crandon. A stepson, Charles Malzahn, died near Pearson several years ago. He also leaves 23 grandchildren; two sisters and one brother. Mrs... Stroth of Glenwood City, Mrs... Kersten of Lake Mills and Ferdinand Kohn of Emerald.
